

What are the eligibility requirements? How do I prepare?



Attendance zone

- The student must reside in an attendance zone of a school on the list of eligible school attendance zones
- Prepare by reviewing if you reside in attendance zone of any of the elementary, middle, and high schools on the list
 - Contact your local school district if you are not aware of your attendance zones



Residency

- Parent must reside in Georgia for 1+ year* *Exception for active-duty military, who must provide orders placing you in the state of Georgia
- Prepare the following required documents:
 - Driver's License or Government Issued ID
 - Utility bill, mortgage statement, bill of house sale, or lease agreement
 - Most recent federal 1040 form



Prior enrollment

- The student must have been enrolled in a Georgia public school for the 2024-25 school year* OR is entering kindergarten *Exception for active-duty military
- Prepare the following required document (unless entering kindergarten):
 - Proof of enrollment (e.g., report card, transcript, enrollment/attendance report)



Future enrollment

- Promise Scholarship recipients must attend private school or home study for the 2025-2026 school year
- Prepare by exploring enrollment opportunities at participating private schools (or developing a home study plan)

Key application information

- Visit MyGeorgiaPromise.org from March 1 April
 15, 2025 to be directed to the application portal
- You can apply at any point during the window; priority is not given based on when you apply
- Official program acceptance decisions will not be made until after the window closes
- Upon submitting the application, you will be informed if the student is eligible, ineligible, or pending further application review
