

## What are the eligibility requirements? How do I prepare?

### Attendance zone

- ❖ The student **must reside in an attendance zone** of a school on the list of eligible school attendance zones
- ❖ Prepare by reviewing if you reside in attendance zone of **any** of the elementary, middle, and high schools on the list
  - Contact your local school district if you are not aware of your attendance zones

### Prior enrollment

- ❖ The student must have been **enrolled in a Georgia public school** for the past two consecutive semesters\* **OR is entering kindergarten**
  - \*Exception for active-duty military that have relocated within the last year*
- ❖ Prepare the following required document:
  - Proof of enrollment (e.g., report card, transcript, enrollment/attendance report)

### Income

- ❖ Unless there are more applicants than funding available, a family's income will not factor into the prioritization of applicants for enrollment in the Fall semester.
- ❖ Only applicants who have a household income level at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) will be considered for enrollment in the Spring semester in accordance with the Promise Scholarship Act

### Residency

- ❖ Parent **must reside in Georgia for 1+ year\***
  - \*Exception for active-duty military who have relocated within the last year; must provide military orders*
- ❖ Prepare the following required documents:
  - Driver's License or Government Issued ID
  - Utility bill, mortgage statement, deed for home, or lease agreement
  - Most recent federal 1040 form

### Future enrollment

- ❖ Promise Scholarship recipients must **attend private school or home study** once they have opted into the program.
- ❖ Prepare by exploring enrollment opportunities at participating private schools (or developing a home study plan)
- ❖ Note: each application period is for enrollment for the following semester

### Important Information

- ❖ Visit [MyGeorgiaPromise.org](http://MyGeorgiaPromise.org) during the next application period to be directed to the application portal
- ❖ You can apply at any point during the window; priority is not given based on when you apply
- ❖ Official program acceptance decisions will not be made until after the window closes

## Managing Applications for Families with Multiple Students

### I already have a child in the program, and would like to add a second child

- ❖ If you would like to add a second child, you can do so during the recertification process. While completing your application, go to Step 5 and add the additional student before submitting.

### I would like to add two students at the same time

- ❖ When applying for the scholarship, you can add multiple students within the same application during Step 5. Select the “Add Student” button at the bottom of the page and continue adding each student. Before moving forward, you will be asked to confirm that all students have been added. If you still need to add another child, select “Go Back.” Once all students are included, select “Yes” to proceed.

### I applied for my two students separately and would like to combine accounts

- ❖ Once applications have been submitted, you are not able to add a second student on the same application. You may complete a separate application for your additional student.
- ❖ To combine accounts, you will need to reach out to the Odyssey Support Team for assistance.

### I accidentally forgot to add a student - what do I do now?

- ❖ If you have not yet submitted your application, you can return to Step 5 and add the student before submitting.
- ❖ If you have already completed and submitted your application and would like to add an additional student, please contact the Odyssey Support Team for help.
